Ukulele tablature for measures 1-4. The key signature has one flat (Bb). The first measure is a whole rest. Measures 2-3 contain the sequence: 3-1-2-1, 3-1-2-1. The fourth measure is a whole rest.

Ukulele tablature for measures 5-8. The fifth measure is a whole rest. Measures 6-7 contain the sequence: 3-1-2-1, 3-1-2-0. The eighth measure contains a whole rest with a fermata.

Calypso and Soca bassline - repeated lots of times!

Ukulele tablature for measures 9-12. The sequence is: 1-1-1-1, 2-2-2-2, 3-3-3-3, 1-1-1-1, 1-1-1-1, 2-2-2-2, 3-3-3-3, 1-1-1-1.

Letter F and G - play four times - Catch the Pigeon

Ukulele tablature for measures 13-16. The sequence is: 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 2-1-2-1, 3-3-1-1.

Ukulele tablature for measures 17-20. Measures 17-19 are whole rests. The twentieth measure contains a triplet of 3 notes, followed by 1-1.

Singing - Mellow Groove. This repeats lots of times - watch the conductor
